Virtues -


This week's virtue is "Kindness".

Foundation stage - The reception children have been playing sound games using objects beginning with the same letter e.g. pig, pen, pot, pencil. In maths they have been singing number songs. We have been talking about our families, drawing pictures and writing our names. Nursery children have been on a listening walk around the school and heard lots of different sounds. We have been singing number rhymes one, two, three, four, five. In Forest School we have played games, picked blackberries to eat at snack time and weeded the flower beds.

Please don't forget Forest School is on a Thursday so children need coats and wellies please.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 - Year 1s have been enjoying learning about London this week and all the significant buildings there. Many of the children have recreated these buildings using different materials in our Small World Area. The children have also been working hard counting amounts up to 10 and writing the numerals correctly. In literacy we have been reading the story 'What the Ladybird Heard on Holiday'. It would be great if the children could read this at home to help them develop their vocabulary. They can either read the book with a grown up or watch a clip on YouTube of the story. In science this week the children have enjoyed planting different plants in the Year 1 outside area and learning their names including a selection of herbs. In art the children have been creating individual pieces to show what the sea means to them ready for the Porthleven Arts Festival.



Year 2- This week the children have been learning about London. They have identified the location of London on a map and found lots of places to visit using maps and photos. In Art, the children made a collage for the Porthleven Arts Festival depicting their version of the sea. In Science, we have enjoyed learning about wild flowers and then finding them in the school grounds. In literacy, we have been reading 'The colour monster', discussing emotions and building a poem. In maths, we continue to look at numbers to 100. Just a reminder, year 2 maths homework will be sent home on Wednesday, please check your child's bag and return completed on the following Monday. It is important that children complete this homework; it helps them consolidate the learning they have achieved in the week and helps parents understand what their child is working on at school.

Key Stage 2

Year 3/4 - What an amazing time on camp we had! The children challenged themselves and the staff at BF Adventure continually commented on their positivity, manners and helpfulness around the camp. I would imagine that they all slept well on their return They completed 6 activities over the 3 days; climbing, quarrysteering, catapulting, low ropes, adrenaline quarry and archery. They were so well behaved that the staff allowed us to use their slip and slide activity during the afternoon. We also completed a night walk. The children that remained at school completed cooking, den-building and many craft activities, ensuring that they had their own experiences that they could share when we all got back together. We would like to say a huge thanks to all involved in making this event happen. There is still a tub of belongings that have not yet been claimed, which will remain outside Mrs. Figgins outside entrance and will be there until Tuesday. Homework for Year 3/4 has now been set. Any questions please your child's class teacher on Monday.

Year 5 - Year 5 started their week with a trip to Helston Museum where they learnt all about how Helston has changed over the years. They were shown how to make a traditional crab/lobster pot. Back in school they created pictures and poems using information they had learnt from the trip ready for their visitors, two ladies from Helston Museum, to come in and teach them all about animation.
