

Crossed lines

Requires:
a few
books

Instructions:

1. Have the students sit in a circle.
2. Whisper the first line of a book to the child on one side of you and the last line to the child on the other.
3. The students relay the line to the next child along and so on, until it makes it's way back to you.
4. Write the results (your new first and last sentences) on the board.
5. For added challenge: ask the students to use the new first line as the start to a story. *Then the next student can add a sentence and so on and so forth till the last child gives the new last line.
Or give it to them as a creative writing challenge to make the new first and last lines connect.
