Foundation stage -

This week the Reception children have continued to be busy with their writing about Penguins and how the adult penguins care for them.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 - Seahorses really enjoyed their dance workshop this week, pretending to be puppets. They all joined in and there were lots of smiles. Photographs will be on google classroom for you to see. The children have also enjoyed writing poems this week all about a person who is special to them. Next week they will have a forest school day on Tuesday to start their new writing unit. They will need to come in with their Forest School clothes on for the day. They will need to wear their PE kits on Wednesday and Thursday next week. It is also SRE week next week. Please see the email that was sent out earlier this week with information regarding the lessons

Year 2- In our topic this week, we learnt about William Caxton and arguable one of the most important inventions of the middle ages, the printing press. In Art, the children studied which artists used 'hot' and 'cold' colours in their work, mixed paints and made their own shades of colour. We had our first dance lesson on Tuesday. Please look on google drive for some photographs. As you will see, the children had a fantastic time. We have another session booked in next week. We also started writing a new story in literacy, Little Red Reading Hood, all about her love of reading. Next week in maths, we will start learning how to tell the 'time'. It would be helpful if you could help prepare them this week by looking at o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past at home. In ICT, we are going to look at presentation skills. We started by learning how to type using the keyboard. In SRE, next week year 2 children will discuss the difference between males and females, body parts and build an awareness of substances /risks around the home and in school which are safe and unsafe. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to talk to me.

Key Stage 2

Year 3/4 - This week, we have been looking in more detail at Dolly Pentreath. Well done Isobel for finding her house in Mousehole. We will continue to build our knowledge of Cornish history over the coming weeks. In Math's, we have started to look at angles and recognizing acute, right and obtuse angles. In music, we have been looking at the work of The Beatles, and the class have learned their first song 'Blackbird', which received a round of applause from the neighbouring classes. The children will be cooking next week and produced their own product design for Fairings. Let's hope they taste as good as they look!





Year 5/6 - This week we have been continuing our story writing in literacy writing effective sentences using alliteration and personification. In science, we have finished our work about circulation looking at the effect of exercise on heart rate and blood pressure and next we will look at how scientists classify living things. The year 6's are now hard at work learning their lines for the end of year play and beginning to practice their scenes, keep a look out for dates for the performances in July. Please can you remind your children to bring water bottles into school as the weather is getting hotter and sun cream/hats for break times and P.E if needed.


