We are asking for your help to get a biomass boiler.

The reason for this is that we would like to replace our existing very old oil boilers with a new biomass boiler. This would allow the school to cut its fuel bills significantly, which will help us manage the school budget, as it is becoming stretched every year. The biomass boiler would help us heat the school, provide hot water in a more energy efficient manner and would also see our reliance on fossil fuels minimised. At present we have to use oil as the area is not supplied with mains gas and use thousands of litres every year. The cost of a biomass boiler will always be outside the scope of our schools budget due to the high costs involved. The only way we will be able to achieve our aim of becoming a self-sufficient school is by gaining funding.
