Foundation stage -

The children in Nursery and Reception have all settled well and are enjoying exploring their new classrooms.

This week the children have learned new number songs and the Reception children have played listening games.

The children have started to paint pictures of themselves looking closely at their features. The Nursery children have enjoyed acting out action songs and singing nursery rhymes some of the children went on a shape and colour walk.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 - The year 1s have settled into their new class brilliantly and have enjoyed getting to know their new learning environment. They have been reading the colour monster this week and understanding different emotions. In geography they have been learning where the UK is on the globe and have been drawing the national flower of England, the rose in art.

Year 2- Welcome back everyone. We have made a great start to the term with our geography topic. The children have been learning which countries make up the United Kingdom by using atlases to locate the countries and tissue paper to make national flags. They are so good I am putting them on our class display. In Art, we continued the UK theme and drew an English Rose. In Science, we have started looking at plants, with the children mind mapping why plants are important in our lives. In literacy, the children have spent all week talking and writing about what they did during the summer holidays. It was great that they all wanted to share their experiences with other members of the class. In maths, we have been looking at numbers to 100. The children have been using resources to build numbers, identifying tens and ones.

We have already collected quite a lot of cardigans and jumpers in the classroom. If your child is missing one please let me know. I would be grateful if you could just check that your child's name is on their clothes. It makes it easier at the end of the day to return them. Thank you.

Key Stage 2

Year 3/4 - Welcome to Narwhals and Swordfish news. The children have settled in really well and it has been so nice to get to chat to them a little more and get to know their interests.

This week, we have added a Welcome PowerPoint to the Google Classroom, along with help guides for homework and other useful websites that your children will be using in school. Your children will be given all their passwords on a sheet to make it easier for you to access the websites found on the classwork page. This sheet will include their Google Classroom log-in. As parents/carers, you have all been sent an invite. Thank you to those that have already set up the account. Letters linked to camp at BF Adventure came home earlier this week. Please contact your class teacher for any further information. Did you know that you can follow your child's quizzing on Accelerated Réader? If you have not yet connected, speak to your class teacher for a letter with all the details you need.

Year 5/6 - The children in Year 5/6 have settled in to the new school year really well. In maths, we have now begun our place value learning and in literacy, we have been re-capping key skills, writing potions for a perfect classmate, and beginning to read our class novels: Herons are reading 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom'; Kestrels are reading 'The Storm Keeper's Island'. Our topic this half-term has a history focus - we will be learning about how the ancient Greeks impacted modern day life. We have an exciting week coming up next week with Year 6 going off to Porthpean Camp and Year 5 visiting Helston Museum and taking part in workshops though the week. We will begin setting weekly homework the week after camp - your child will be coming home with information about this soon.
