

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Forgiveness

Forgiveness helps us to feel free of that heavy weight and to live life in the present. It is also important to learn to forgive ourselves, when we have made a mistake. Forgiveness allows us to move on from things and supports our growth and happiness.



Virtues -

This week's virtue is "Forgiveness".

<u>Foundation stage -</u> This week the children have been busy practising their songs for the Nativity and rehearsing their lines.

We have been looking at all the different celebrations Bonfire night, Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas and talking about the similarities and differences.

In maths the Reception children have been exploring shape looking for shapes all around and creating repeating patterns.

The Nursery children have been exploring the number 3, counting objects and using the numicon

tiles and Lego to show they know the value of 3.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 - Year 1 have been enjoying practicing for the Christmas play this week. They have been reading the story of The Mousehole Cat and exploring some of the vocabulary used in the story. If you have a copy of the story at home please share it together or look for a copy on youtube which the children can listen to. In maths we have been finishing our unit on addition, using the addition and subtraction symbols. Today we started to learn subtraction by crossing out when we take something away. Then we will learn other strategies to subtract next week. We are also writing Christmas lists next week. We will focus on adjectives to describe the things they want "a giant, fluffy teddy" so please talk about this with them. Next week is a busy week full of performances. Please can you make sure the children are at school at 5:30 on Monday and Wednesday, ready for the evening performances.

Year 2- More play practice this week! The children are very excited (and nervous) about their performances next week. The children have also enjoyed their Christmas crafts that will continue until the end of term. In literacy, we have started a new book, The Storm Whale. The children came up with some great ideas for helping a 'beached whale'. In maths, we continue to work on subtraction. Although this has been a difficult unit, I have been very impressed on how hard the children have worked. Year 2 have now completed their phonics screening test. A letter informing you of their results will be arriving soon. We have a very busy week of performances ahead. We would be grateful if you can make sure your child is back at school at 5.30 on Monday and Wednesday. Thank you.

Key Stage 2

Year 3/4 - Firstly, thank you to supporting Years 3 and 4 last Friday for our Christmas Songs. We hoped you enjoyed it and we look forward to organising something more to share in the Spring term.

This week, the children have continued with their history topic and we are beginning to explore the start of the Iron Age and examine why hill forts were used and how they were made as safe as possible.

The children have started their next math topic – multiplication and division. Year 3 are starting to build their knowledge and fluency of the 3x, 4x and 8x times tables between now and the end of the term. Year 4 are building their fluency across all their times tables.

As we enter the last two weeks, we will be completing our final assessments to measure how much the children have achieved this term.

Year 5/6 - Year 5/6 are continuing to learn about volcanoes and have been comparing and contrasting their similarities and differences. In art lessons, children have enjoyed making clay pots and, once glazed, they will bring them home. The children are currently publishing their explanation texts on the lifecycle of the praying mantis these are already looking fantastic. Some Year 6 children have begun their bikeability course. Any other Year 6's who would like to take part next week needs to bring a bike, helmet and consent form on Wednesday.
