# **Key Stage 1**

**Year 1** - Year 1 have had a busy week starting the story of Little Red Riding Hood in literacy. They enjoyed walking around the 'forest' and pretending to be Little Red Riding Hood to help them with their writing. We have also started a new topic in Geography which is 'Extreme Weather'. In science we are learning about materials and their properties. The children enjoyed sorting different materials into groups. In maths we have been adding and subtracting numbers up to 20. The children really enjoyed World Book Day! We had lots of fantastic costumes and bag designs. We would also like to welcome Miss Osborne into the Year 1 team who will be training with us to be a teaching assistant.

**Year 2-** This term our new topic is about Weather, a geography topic. We will look at weather patterns in the UK and around the world. In our first lesson, the children created a mind map of different types of weather and chose some to write details about. In Art, the children identified hot and cold colours in paintings and generated some of these colours themselves. We have had two science lessons this week, one comparing children's hands span and a second experimenting with materials to find out which material is most suitable for a bouncy ball. In Maths, we have started a topic on statistics and in literacy; we have begun a new writing programme, 'The Write Stuff'. The work in based on the book 'Stardust'. I have been very impressed at the work the children have completed at this early stage. I am looking forward to meeting with you all next week at parents evening. # **Key Stage 2**

**Year 3/4 -** This week, the children have started their new topic on The Roman Empire. They have looked at how they were excellent designers and engineers, with a focus on Roman architecture in Design and Technology. In maths we have started looking at length, where we have been measuring with accuracy. In literacy, we have begun our journey to unpick a story and write in smaller, but more precise steps. The children are thoroughly enjoying this new method of completing out writing, which you will see at the parents evenings. The children had great fun dressing up as their favourite book and we had fun guessing who we all were. Thank you to all those that have signed up to see me next week and I look forward to seeing you.
